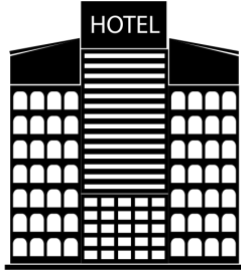

# Security and Access to Event Premises

- Access to the Official Event premises within the Kempinski Hotel Muscat will be strictly limited to persons wearing an Event Badge.

### **Currency:**

The Omani Rial is divided into 1,000 Baizas. OMR 1 is approximately US\$ 2.58. Currency notes are available in denominations of OMR 50, 20, 10, 5 and 1. Currency notes are also available in 100 baizas and half-Rial denominations.

Arabic is the official language of Oman. English, Hindi, Swahili are among the other languages widely spoken.
